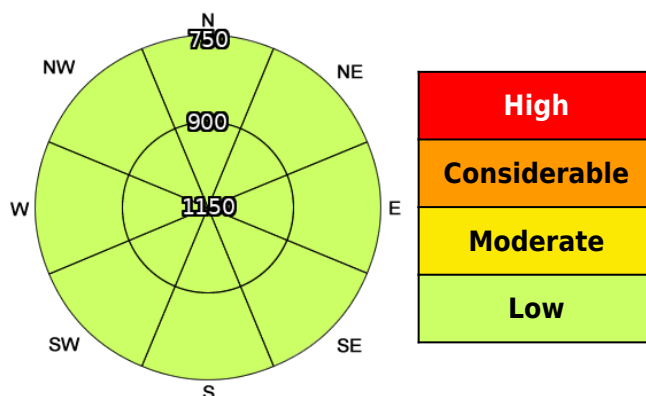


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 16/04/2015****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The remaining snowpack will be generally well bonded and stable on all aspects and at all altitudes. Surface layers however will soften during the day at lower elevations as the freezing level rises towards the summits. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will be an overcast but dry day. Light to moderate West becoming North-Westerly winds. From an overnight low of 750 metres, the freezing level will gradually rise to 1200 metres by the late afternoon.

Soft, wet snow will firm up overnight.
