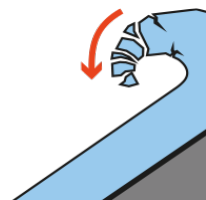
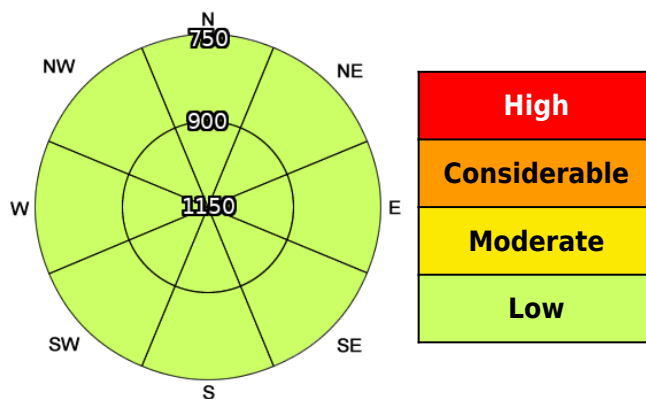


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 17/04/2015****Avalanche Problems****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The surface layers of the patchy snow will gradually soften as the freezing level rises but will remain generally stable. Milder conditions will increase the hazard presented by falling rocks and cornice remnant collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Remaining dry with light, North-North-Easterly winds, slowly veering Easterly. Overnight freezing level at 1000 metres, gradually rising to 1400 metres by the end of the day.
