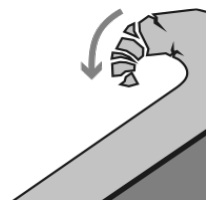

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 18/04/2015

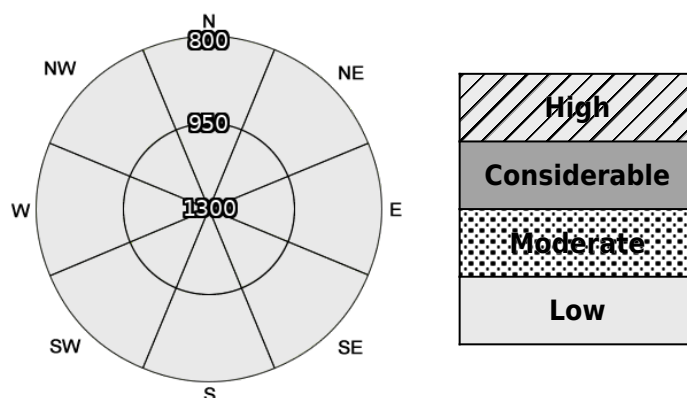
Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack which remains on North-West through North and East to South-East aspects above 950 metres will become firmer overnight before softening in the surface layers during the day. Stability will be good in all areas. Surface instabilities could affect steep sun exposed slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry with sunny spells and light variable winds. Freezing around summit levels overnight, rising to well above summits during the day.

Comments

Dry settled conditions, more sunshine expected tomorrow.
