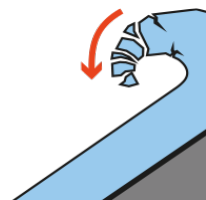
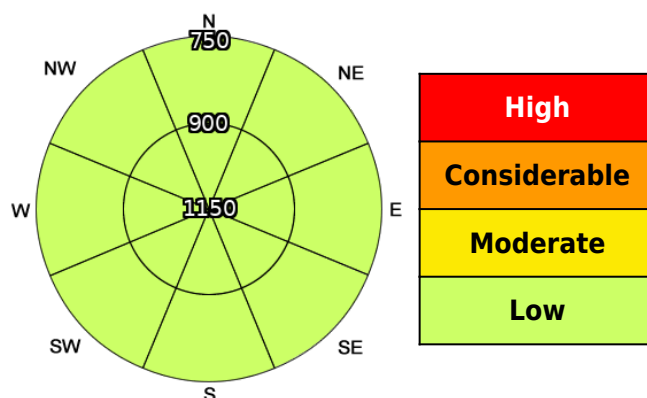


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 19/04/2015****Avalanche Problems****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The remaining snow will firm up overnight in the sub-zero temperatures before softening again during the day. Conditions will be generally stable but with loose, moist surface layers, widening glide cracks and slumping cornice remnants. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

At 900 metres temperatures will drop below freezing overnight before rising during the day to plus 5 degrees. There will be a 3000 metre freezing level with dry but partly cloudy conditions. Moderate North veering East-North-Easterly winds.
