

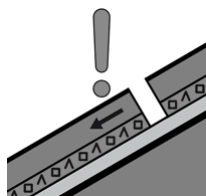

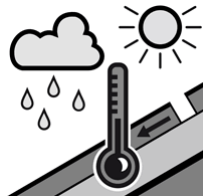

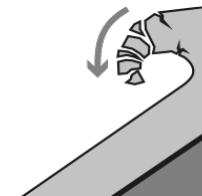
Wind Slab



Persistent Weak Layers



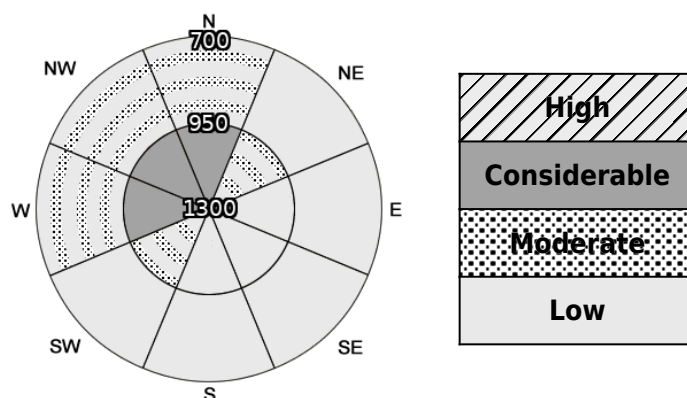

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be a period of increased instability during the rise in temperature and onset of rain. Avalanches are likely especially in areas of steep and convex terrain on Westerly to Northerly aspects above 950 metres. Instabilities will affect other aspects where recently cross loaded deposits have formed. Cornices will be unstable. Elsewhere will be mostly well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight light sleet and rain at all levels on moderate South-Easterly winds. Dry during the day, with moderate to strong winds veering South-Westerly. The freezing level will rise to above the summits.
