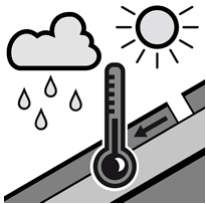


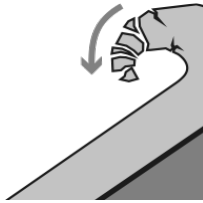

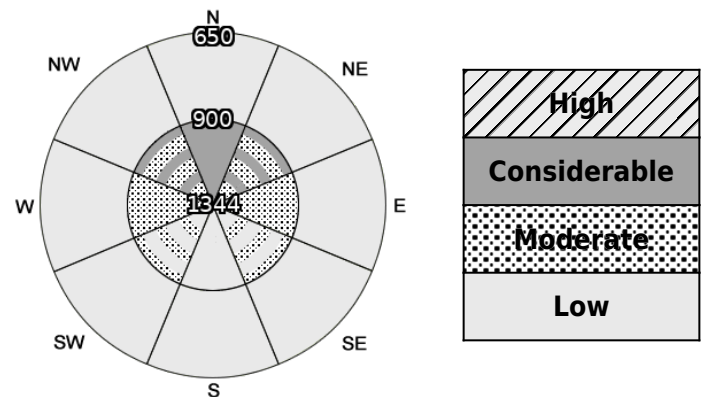
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be a period of instability overnight as the fresh snow from Sunday becomes saturated. Stability will improve slightly through the day. However, wet snow instabilities will remain, mainly on North-West to North-East aspects above 900 metres. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

After a mild night with some rain at all levels it will be a generally dry day. The freezing level will drop to just above the higher summits.
