
**Avalanche Problems**



Wet Snow

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Any snow that exists will be limited to patches above 900 metres on North to North-East aspects around corrie rims and ridge flanks. The snowpack will be very moist but generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Overnight heavy rain at all levels, during the day some drier conditions should prevail. Strong winds will be South-South-Westerly and the freezing well above the summits.

**Comments**

Another mild damp day. Some slightly cooler conditions are forecast for late Saturday as the freezing level lowers to 1500 metres.
