



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 20/12/2015

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

At first the limited snow patches will continue to thaw. Later in the period snow will fall on higher ground. Small pockets of windslab will form onto North to Easterly aspects above 900m. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South-South-Westerly winds overnight turning South-West later. Cooler temperatures as the freezing level falls to summit levels by the early morning. Rain showers will continue, these turning to sleet and snow at higher elevations.
