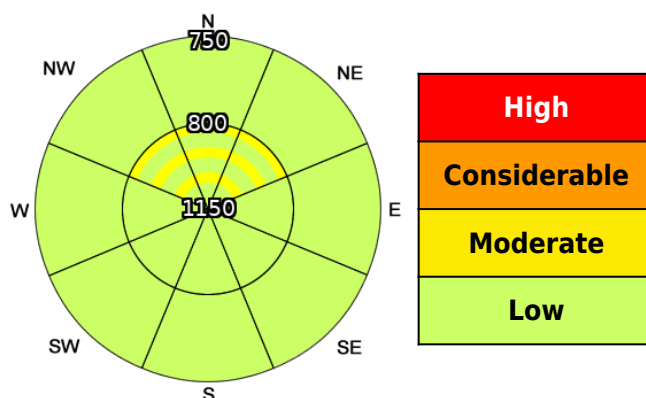


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 21/12/2015****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The old moist snowpack will consolidate further. New snow is expected above 800 metres, the greatest accumulations being on North-West to North-East aspects. Localised windslab deposits will start to develop in sheltered locations, especially at the tops of gullies and corrie headwalls. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

There will be strong to gale force winds generally from a South-Westerly direction. Light showery precipitation falling as snow above 900 metres overnight, followed by occasional heavier snow showers during the day above 600 metres. The freezing level will slowly fall during the period to around 900 metres.

Comments

Strong winds will continue with more wintry showers as the period progresses.
