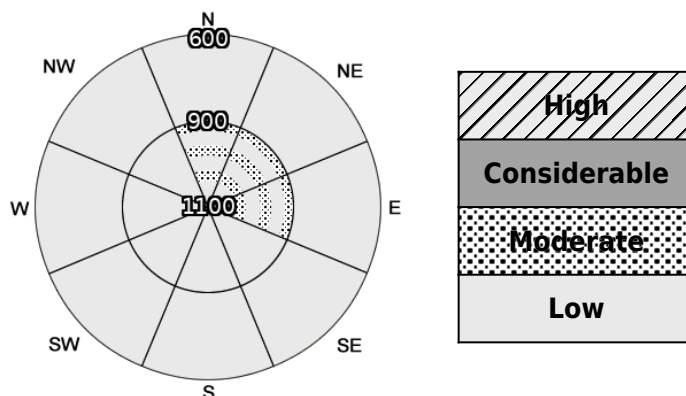
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The sparse snowpack and old deposits will remain stable. There will be some fresh accumulations of windslab possible above 900m on North to East facing aspects in steep gully tops and around coire rims. Some new cornice development will also develop above slopes of these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

A showery South-West airflow will continue to affect the area. Freezing levels will fluctuate to below summits resulting in further deposits of snow at highest elevations down to 600m. Winds will remain strong to gale force generally South-Westerly throughout.
