

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing fresh wet snow will thaw during the brief warm and wet spell early on Tuesday. During the day, new localised areas of fresh snow will start to form in sheltered locations. Accumulations will be localised and generally restrict to the tops of steep North, North-East and East facing slopes and gullies above 1000 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong Southerly winds overnight will become South-Westerly during Tuesday. Early in the morning there will be a period of rain at all levels. During the afternoon there will be snow showers above 1000m.
