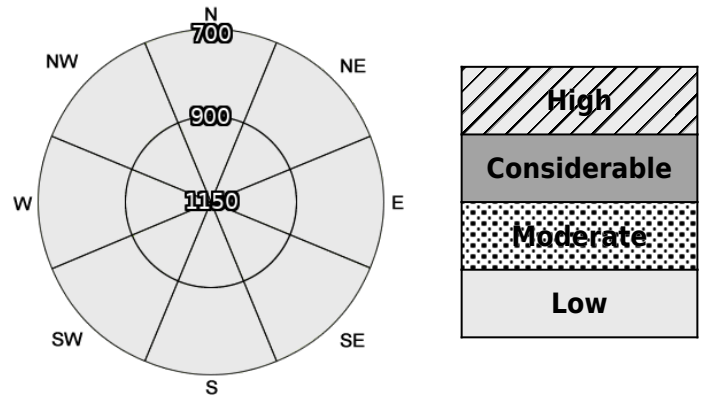
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old existing areas of snow will remain firm. New localised accumulations of moderately bonded windslab will develop mainly around gully tops and corrie rims on North-West to North-East aspects above 950 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Heavy showers continuing during the night and into tomorrow with some occasionally falling as snow above 850 metres as the freezing level fluctuates around the summits. The winds will remain strong to gale force mainly from the South-West.

Comments

A mixture of heavy rain and occasional snow showers over the summits.
