



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 22/12/2015

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Initially the present dusting of snow will thaw in the heavy rain showers. Deposits of snow will build again at summit levels during tomorrow as the freezing level decreases. Pockets of Wind Slab instabilities will form on North- Easterly aspects especially on corrie rims and gully tops, above 700 metres. Below this altitude the hills will remain bare. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Very strong Southerly winds will turn South-Westerly. Heavy rain is expected. The freezing level will lower again tomorrow morning with light snow showers expected at summit levels.

Comments

A fresh dusting of new snow on the tops laying mainly on bare ground; however there were very small isolated patches of older snow remaining on high Easterly aspects which will now have a dusting of new snow where instabilities may be present.
