



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 23/12/2015

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

As the cooler air arrives snow will fall on the summits above around 700 metres. Very localised areas of wind slab instabilities will develop on North-Easterly aspects especially around corrie rims and gully tops. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Very strong South-West winds turning West-South-West then South-South-West later. The freezing level will lower to around 700 metres after the recent warming period. Snow showers are expected at higher altitudes.
