
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will become firm and more stable in the cooler temperatures. New accumulations of unstable wind slab will develop on northerly to easterly aspects above 950 metres. Steep terrain, corrie rims and gully tops will be most affected. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Throughout the forecast period frequent snow showers are expected above 500 metres on strong to gale force South-Westerly winds. The freezing level will fall to 700 metres.
