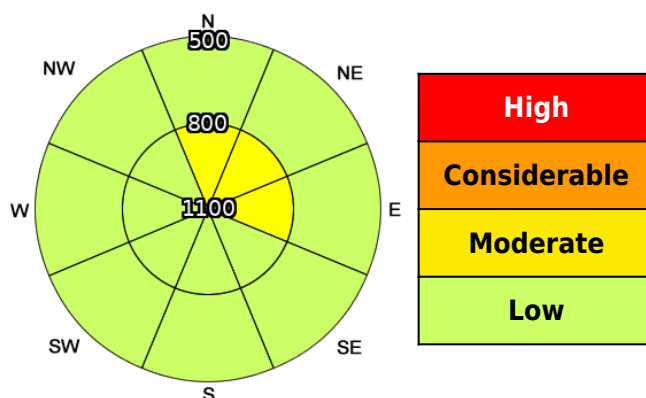

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be some fresh deposits of snow above 500m on North to East aspects. New snow instabilities will exist in steepest gully tops above 800m where deepest accumulations of windblown snow develop. Some new cornice development will also occur around coire rims, above slopes of these aspects. Good stability in all other locations. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A showery West to South-Westerly will become cooler and bring frequent snow showers overnight and during the day, above 400 - 500m. Winds will be very strong mostly South-Westerly throughout.
