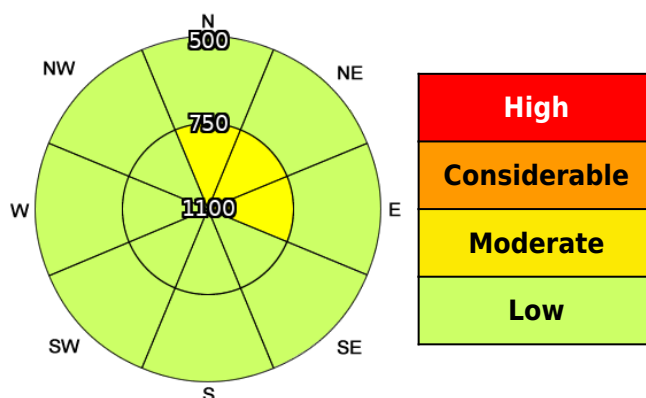

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A period of poor stability overnight as snow turns to rain at all levels. Brief improvement in stability before new moderately bonded windslab begins to develop on steep North to East aspects above 750m. Good stability on all wind exposed aspects. Cornices will be unstable for a time overnight, then new cornice development later. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Stormy, mild and wet overnight. Progressively colder during the day with snow showers on strong South West winds.

Comments

Rain at all levels overnight with plus 2 degrees C. summit temps becoming -4.5 degrees C. later. Period of poor stability overnight.
