




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be further accumulations of fresh snow above 500m on North to East aspects. New snow instabilities will exist in steepest gully tops above 800m where deep accumulations of new windblown snow develop. Some new cornice build up will also form around coire rims above slopes of these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

The showery West to South Westerly airflow will cool and bring frequent further snow showers overnight down to 4- 500m. These will die out early during the day. Winds, initially strong West South Westerly will become Southerly then East South East, easing Easterly as the day progresses.

Comments

Cooler again with showery conditions bringing hope of a winter landscape for Xmas day.
