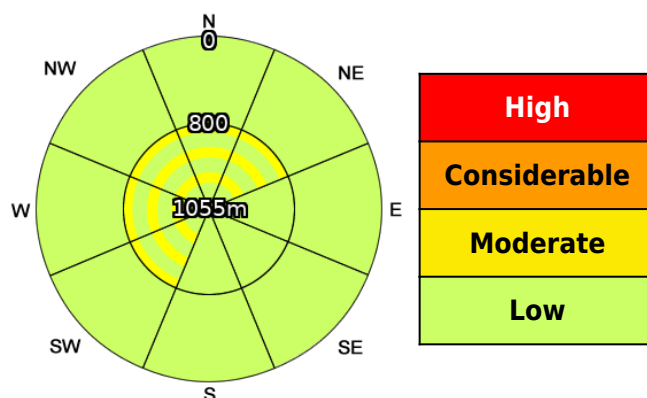
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of unstable windslab will continue to form on Westerly to Northerly aspects above 800 metres. Steep gully exits and corrie rims will be most affected. Additional accumulations due to cross loading of will affect South-West and North-East aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong Easterly winds easing overnight to around 20mph during the day and veering South-West to South-East later. Snowfall overnight will clear by dawn. Freezing level gradually rising to summit levels by the end of the forecast period.
