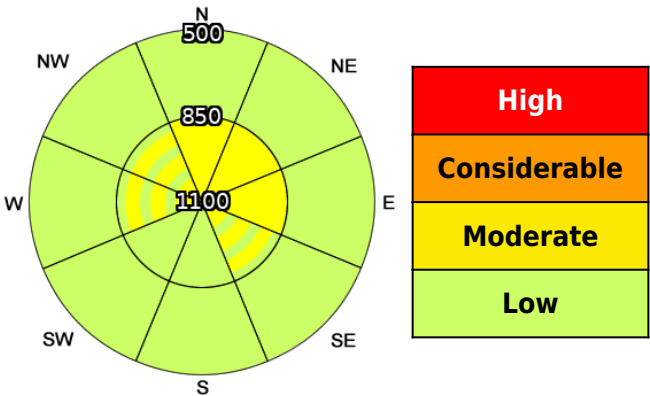

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fluctuating temperatures will bring some early consolidation to recent snow accumulations before dawn. New moderately bonded windslab will develop on at the heads of steeper North to East facing gullies and the tops of coire backwalls above 850m. More significant cornice development expected above all very steep lee slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers dying out in the early hours. Winds easing for a time before becoming moderate to strong West -South -Westerly. Milder for a time overnight then cooler with the freezing level falling to 900m.

Comments

Trail breaking tiring high on lee slopes. Much faster travel on ridges and wind exposed locations. Covering of new snow above 400m today.
