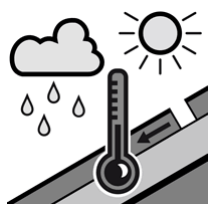


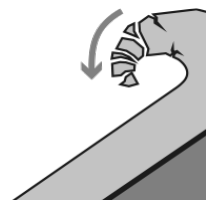

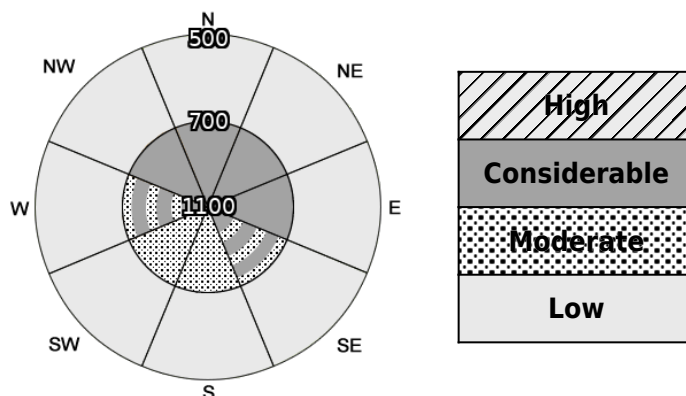
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poor stability overnight on steep West through North to South-East aspects above 700m. Persistent mild temperatures and rain will maintain wet snow instability in all these locations throughout the day. Better stability on exposed ridges. Significant snow loss and collapsing cornices in prospect. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Freezing level rising abruptly to 2800m overnight and remaining close to 2000m for the rest of the day. A little light rainfall in the afternoon. Very strong South-East winds throughout.

Comments

Trail breakathlon away from the beaten path on Sunday. Covering of fresh snow above 400m but a turbo thaw expected over the forecast period.
