
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A continued diminishing, patchy and stable snowpack remains mainly on North to East aspects above 750 metres. By morning, a dusting of fresh snow will exist on the highest summits and ridges. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Generally Southerly winds will ease overnight to around 20 mph by daybreak increasing to gale force later. Clearing overnight rain, turning to snow for a time as the freezing level lowers to summits, and a dry day thereafter.

Comments

A very warm day, feeling like summer walking at times. Tuesday will be another reasonable day after overnight rain, but cooler.
