

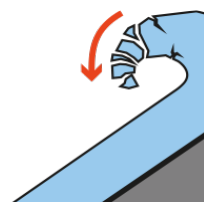

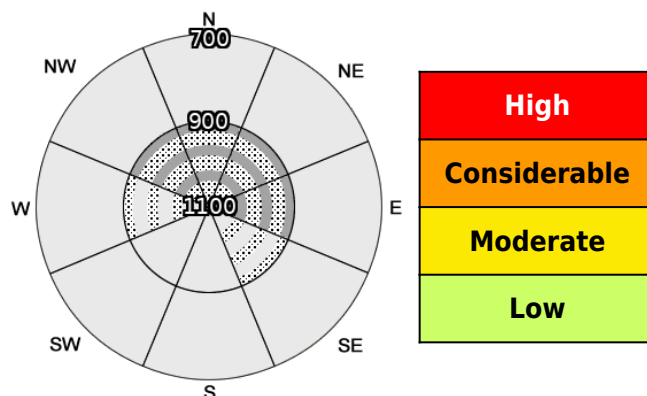

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A period of poor stability with the arrival of rain overnight on steep West through North to East aspects above 900m. Stability will improve thereafter in all locations by morning as the cooler airflow and fluctuating temperatures begin to affect the area. Any recently weakened cornices however will remain suspect. Good stability on exposed ridges. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Initially rain at all levels accompanied by strong South Easterly winds. Freezing levels will lower overnight to around summits and a dry day is then expected with lighter Southerly winds for a period. These will increase again by mid morning from the South-East, with very strong gusts up to 100 mph over summits areas.

Comments

Steady thaw. Some improved stability with arrival of cooler overnight conditions. Very strong SE winds forecast over summits on Tuesday.
