
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of windslab will develop in the afternoon on North to North East aspects above 800 metres. Steep corrie backwalls and gully exits will be most affected. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, heavy rain with severe gale force South-South -East winds, easing by daylight and turning to showers. Winds Southerly 30 mph by the end of the day. Very mild overnight, freezing level dropping below summits by the afternoon. Showers turning increasingly to snow above 600 metres by the end of the forecast period.

Comments

A day mainly of snow showers, some heavy mid afternoon and strong to gale force winds, slowly easing by the end of the day. Getting colder throughout the day.
