





**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Some new moderately well bonded snow accumulations will develop on mostly North-West to North-Easterly aspects above 900 metres. Steep places such as Coire rims, gully exits and ridge flanks in the highest locations will be most affected and especially where windslab deposits achieve any depth. Elsewhere accumulations will be thin and on bare ground. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Some snowfall overnight clearing early morning. Winds, strong West South-Westerly overnight backing South then South-Easterly during the day. Freezing level around 400 metres with snow lying to around 200 metres.
