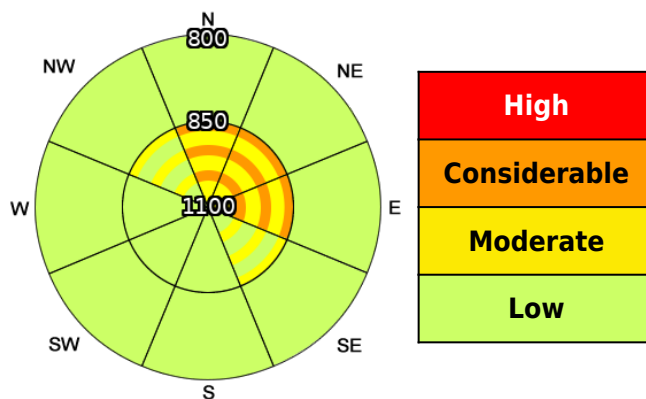

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Good stability on all slopes exposed to the wind. New marginally bonded windslab will accumulate on steeper North to East aspects above 850m. Most affected areas will be gully exits and the top of steep scarp slopes. Some new soft cornice development expected over steepest lee slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Some overnight snow showers on strong South-West to West-South-West winds, easing later. Freezing level around 500m throughout.

Comments

Cosmetic cover of thin snow on Thursday disguising an otherwise sparse and patchy snowpack. Some more snow expected overnight and into New Years Day morning. Snowfall down to 200m for a time overnight.
