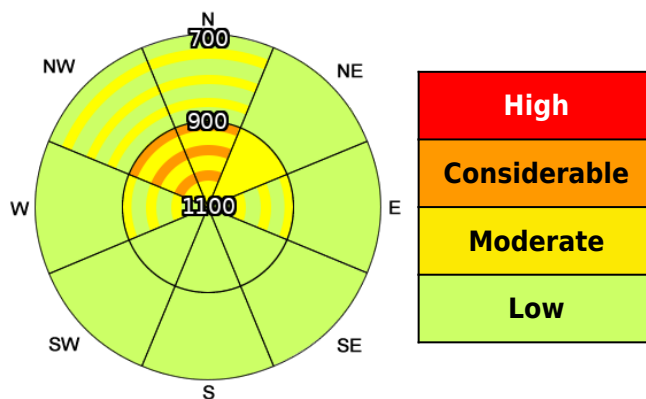

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Good stability in many locations especially those exposed to recent wind scouring. Localised accumulations of marginally to moderately bonded windslab on very steep North West to North aspects above 900m. New minor cornice development at the top of steeper lee slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers overnight and during the day. Strong South Easterly airflow easing later. Steady rise in freezing level to around summits.

Comments

Localised poor stability limited to the higher lee slopes on New Years Day. Distribution of instability looking similar for Saturday though on NW to N aspects. Superficial covering of snow in many places today.
