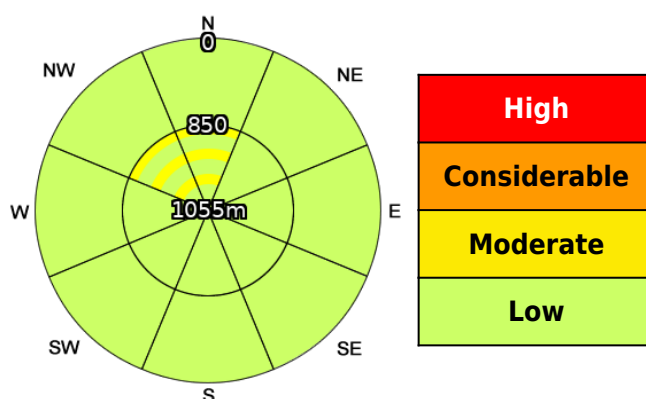


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 03/01/2016****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

A generally consolidating snowpack as the freezing level lowers during the day. However, minor instabilities will remain where there are significant localised areas of moist snow, such as in gully tops, corrie rims and ridge flanks on North-West to North aspects above 850 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Continuing gale force Easterly winds, strengthening to 50 mph by the end of the day. Insignificant amounts of precipitation overnight leaving a dry day. A cold end to the day as the freezing level drops to 800 metres from above the summits overnight.

Comments

Continuing relatively dry with gale force Easterly winds. Becoming a bit colder.
