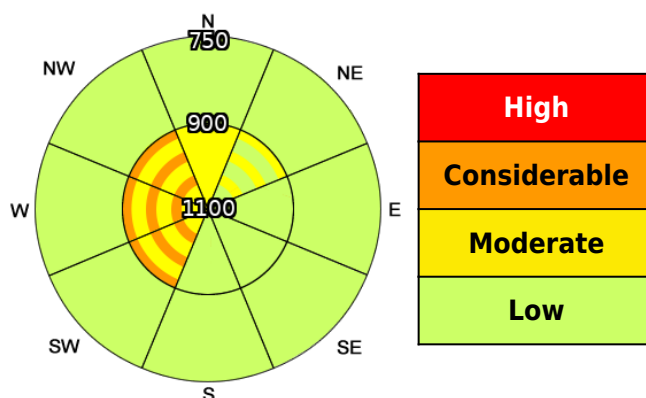
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh accumulations of unstable windslab will be deposited with greatest accumulations in sheltered gullies and around corrie rims on South-West to North-West aspects above 900 metres. The older snowpack will freeze and become mainly stable as the temperature drops. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong East-South-East winds with showers throughout the period falling as snow above 900 metres overnight and down to 600 metres during the day. Freezing level slowly dropping to 700 metres.

Comments

Old wet snowpack starting to freeze above 900 metres. Snow melting and only patches left lower down.
