

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 06/01/2016


Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain generally stable with a thin crust on the surface in many places. Localised areas of moderately bonded fresh snow will be present, mainly at the tops of sheltered West, North-West and North aspects above 1100m. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

No significant precipitation expected. Winds will gradually increase again and veer to the South-East. Freezing level will remain around 800m.
