

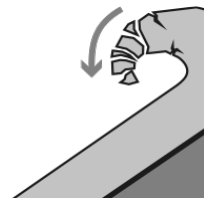

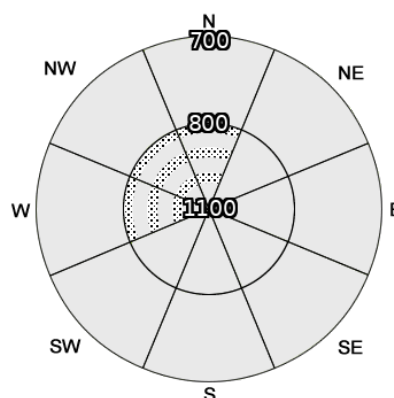
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Sparse and patchy snowpack. Some new thin and moderately bonded windslab on steep and sheltered West to North aspects above 800m. Colder temperatures will maintain good stability on wind scoured old snowpack. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Some light snow showers throughout the period on moderate to strong East, later South East winds. Freezing level around 650m.

Comments

Little or nil new snow in our area on Tuesday. Very patchy snowpack. Thin smears of ice beginning to form on a few classic Meggie ice routes, otherwise the crags looking black. Principal low grade gully lines are very thin or broken.
