
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The older snowpack will remain generally stable. Fresh unstable windslab will develop with greatest accumulations on steep, wind sheltered West to North aspects above 900 metres. North-East to East aspects will also be affected later in the day. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South-East winds veering South-West and decreasing in the afternoon. Occasional showers overnight, falling as snow above 800 metres becoming frequent and falling to lower levels during the day. Freezing level 900 metres falling to 600 metres in the afternoon.
