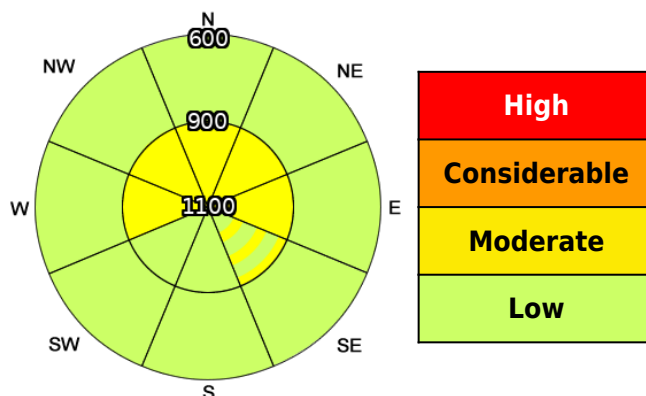
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh snow and redistribution of the existing snow will cause a build up of localised unstable windslab mainly on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Some localised unstable windslab will also remain on West to North-West aspects. The older snowpack is generally frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate Westerly wind with snow showers dying out during the night. Wind then backing to light Easterly and becoming mainly dry. Freezing level around 550 metres.
