


### THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE

#### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 09/01/2016

##### Avalanche Problems

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A light dusting of snow will exist above 600 metres; However, Instabilities will remain in very localised pockets of windslab found mainly on steep slopes such as gully exits and corrie rims on North-East to East aspects above 850 metres. Areas of old snow will remain firm and icy. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Light Easterly winds initially, strengthening to around 30mph during the day. Some light snow showers early afternoon, but short lived. The freezing level will hover around 500 metres throughout the period.

##### Comments

Beautiful day for mountain travel. General snowcover is cosmetic, with heavy riming at higher levels. Ridges and summits look Alpine.
