

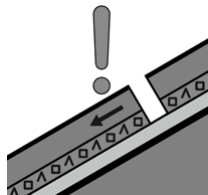

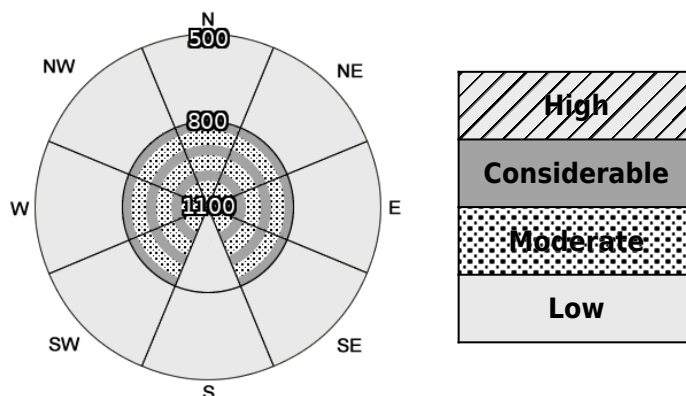
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will remain mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. During the day redistribution and later some fresh snowfall will cause a build up of fresh windslab mainly on steep, sheltered South-West to North-West aspects above 800 metres. Exposed areas will be hard and icy. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Light East-South-East winds overnight backing East and increasing through the day. Mainly dry with some snow showers in the afternoon. Freezing level around 500 metres.
