

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of fresh unstable windslab will form on South-West to North-West aspects mainly above 800 metres due to wind redistribution. Existing areas of unstable windslab will remain on North to East aspects. Areas most affected will be gully exits and steep summit slopes. Quantities are not expected to be great. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The wind will be from an Easterly direction and increase moderate to strong. It will be generally dry with only light snow at the end of the period. The freezing level will be around 400 to 500 metres.

Comments

Widespread shallow fresh snow above 750 metres. More changeable forecast for the weekend.
