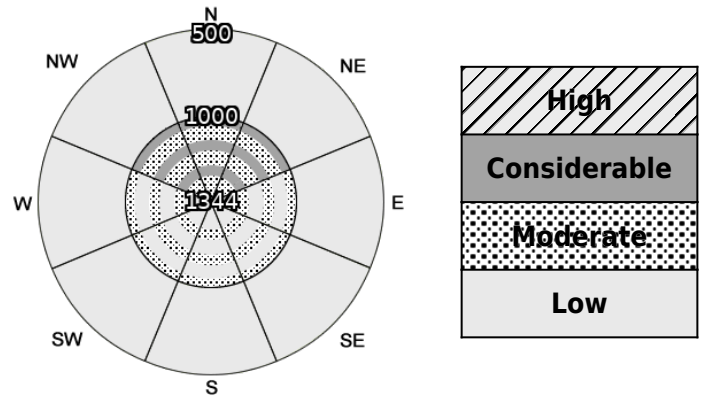

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Variable winds will produce localised areas of moderately bonded snow on many aspects. Greatest accumulations will be on sheltered North-West, North and North-East aspects above 1000m. Other aspects will also be affected. In other locations, fresh snow accumulations will be shallow. Wind exposed slopes will be frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be light to moderate and variable in direction through out the period. Snow showers above 500m during Sunday
