

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 11/01/2016


Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Instabilities will remain in very localised areas of windslab on South-West to West aspects in steep locations above 850 metres. Fresh windslab will also accumulate in small amounts in localised areas on North-West to North-East aspects at similar altitude and locations. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow down to 650 metres, mainly during the day, but amounts will be small. Fresh Easterly winds will ease by dawn, becoming light South to South-Westerly, backing Easterly later. The freezing level will hover around 600 metres throughout the day.

Comments

Milder, less windy and less snow than expected today. Brighter on the coastal mountains. Good walking conditions. More of the same for tomorrow?
