

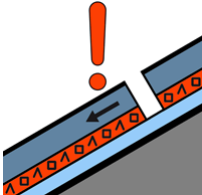

Avalanche Problems



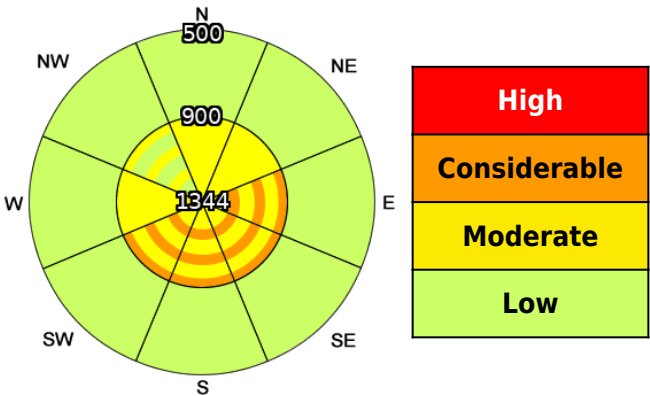
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will be present on many aspects. Initially greatest accumulations will be on North to East aspects above 900 metres but further snow and redistribution will cause a unstable windslab to build on South to South-West aspects by dawn and East to South-East aspects during the day. Ridges exposed to the wind will be icy. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light South-West winds initially, then moderate North-East backing Westerly. Snow showers overnight then mainly dry. Freezing level around 600 metres.

Comments

Wind directions will change a lot in the next 24 hours and be strong enough to cause drifting and redistribution of snow. The aspects with the greatest hazard will also change throughout the period.
