
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Due to variable winds localised wind slab instabilities will develop and become more wide spread affecting many aspects above 700 metres. Corrie rims and steep gully tops will be especially affected. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers becoming heavier during the day. Moderate to strong North-Easterly winds will back through North to the West. Freezing level will be at 600 metres.

Comments

Although road side areas are free of snow. The snow pack is building at higher altitudes and feels increasingly wintry.
