
# Avalanche Hazard Forecast - FOR PERIOD 18:00HRS Mon 11/01/2016 TO 18:00HRS Tue 12/01/2016



Hazard Level	Avalanche Probabilty
Very High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. Numerous very large, often extremely large natural avalanches can be expected.
High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. In some cases, numerous large, often very large sized natural avalanches can be expected.
Considerable	Natural and human triggered avalanches possible, in some cases large, in isolated cases very large sized natural avalanches are possible.
Moderate:	Very large sized natural avalanches are unlikely. Human triggering possible in indicated steep places.
Low	Only small and medium sized natural avalanches are possible. Human triggering possible in steep, extreme terrain.

### Forecast Weather Influences

Variable winds through the period. Initially light Southerly; increasing moderate North-East overnight, then backing North-West and later Westerly. Light snow showers above 500 metres overnight and early morning. The freezing level will be around 600 metres.

# Forecast Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

Due to existing weaknesses, fresh snowfall and the redistribution of existing snow, unstable windslab will be present in sheltered areas on many aspects mainly above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

# Observed Avalanche Hazard - Mon 11/01/2016

### Observed Weather Influences

There was some overnight snowfall at most levels with moderate South-West winds. During the day light snow fell above 400 metres on mainly light South or South-West winds. The freezing level was around 600 metres.

# Observed Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

Fresh moderately to poorly bonded windslab is present in sheltered areas, mainly on steep North-West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. Accumulations are generally localised. Weaknesses remain in the older windslab lying on other aspects. The avalanche hazard is Considerable.

# Observed Mountain Travel Conditions Fresh snow cover at most levels, with deep deposits in places. Very poor visibility throughout the day above 600 metres. Winds approx 10mph or less. Comments Complicated weather around an area of low pressure. Low confidence in forecasted snow amounts. Check up to date sources in the morning and adjust mountain travel plans accordingly.
