

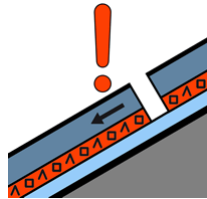

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snow redistribution will take place through out the period onto a variety of aspects. Localised areas of poorly bonded snow will be present, mainly at the tops of gullies and corrie rims above 900m. Larger areas of moderately bonded snow will also be present, greatest accumulations will be in North and East facing corries. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable
