

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Further wind slab instabilities will build on all aspects above 800 metres, especially on North-East through South to West . Most affected will be corrie rims and gullies. Below this altitude instabilities will be more isolated on these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Fresh winds will be East-North-Easterly, becoming variable. Winds will back to the West-South-West by the end of the forecast period. Freezing level will hover at 300 metres. There will be moderate snow showers through the day.
