



Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Very cold temperatures will maintain localised instability mainly on North through East to South aspects above 900m. Most affected areas will be steep and very sheltered gully exits and the top of scarp slopes. Areas of moderately bonded older windslab will persist on very sheltered locations above 900m on other aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Very cold and dry though with some very light snow showers in the afternoon. Light to moderate East- North-East winds backing through North, becoming South Westerly later.

Comments

Most recent cornices remain fragile. Hard going in drifted snow on Wednesday. Better cover now on all plateau areas.
