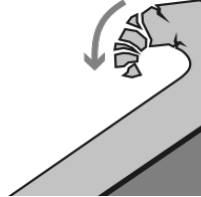

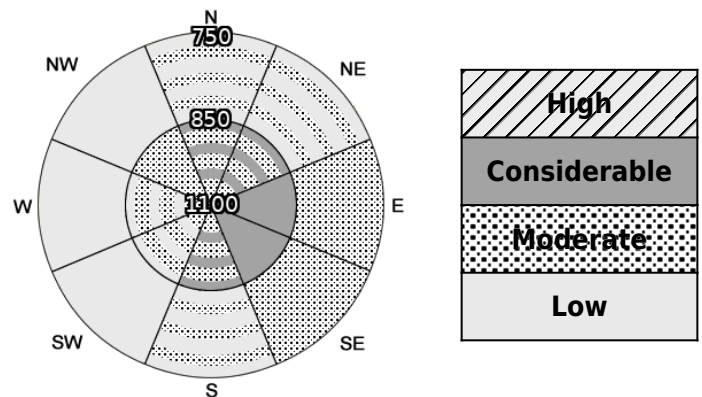

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

In addition to snow showers, stronger winds will redistribute snow as wind slab mainly on steep, sheltered East to South East aspects above 850m. North, North East and South aspects above the same altitude will also be affected but here more localised. Better stability on persistently wind scoured slopes. New weak cornice development over steeper lee slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers throughout on stronger West or North West winds. Staying very cold.

Comments

Persistent steep temperature gradient making snowpack weaknesses more obvious in deep and shallow snow. Very cold air temperatures today. Late drifting onto E to SE aspects.
