

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 19/01/2016


Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Instabilities will persist in localised areas of windslab, mainly on South-West through West to North aspects above 800 metres. Steep slopes will be most affected, particularly gully tops, corrie rims and ridge flanks. Above 800 metres, localised areas of windslab on other aspects will generally consolidate. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

High pressure will dominate. It will be generally stable, cold with light Easterly winds and sunny spells. No precipitation is expected. Freezing level will hover around 600 metres during the day.

Comments

Looking forward to a period of settled weather with clearer skies. Cold conditions will maintain instabilities in the snowpack. High windchill effect today.
