
Wind Slab

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Localised areas of weakly bonded wind slab will remain on all aspects above 800 metres where there will initially be some redistribution of snow especially onto West and North aspects. Localised snow instabilities will also be present on South-West through West to North aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Moderate East winds will veer South-Easterly and ease by the end of the period. Light snow showers are expected this evening. The freezing level will fluctuate around 600 metres.

**Comments**

Some consolidation in the snow pack at all levels, the steeper still exists, although thawing on paths.
