

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 19/01/2016


Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of unstable windslab will remain mainly on West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. Steep gullies, corrie rims and scarp slopes will be most affected. Localised instabilities will be present on steep terrain on many other aspects. Below 750 metres the snowpack will be more consolidated and generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light East backing South-East winds. Mainly dry. Freezing level around 600 metres.

Comments

A warmer day today has helped the consolidation process but weaknesses remain on many aspects.
