

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 20/01/2016


Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weaknesses remain in the snow pack on all aspects above 800 metres. These are mainly on localised West to North aspects above 800 meters where steep terrain such as gully tops and scarp slopes will be most affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

The ridge of high pressure will maintain quiet and settled conditions. The wind will be moderate South - West variable, then backing East - South - East tomorrow. The freezing level will fluctuate around 600 to 700 metres.

Comments

Very localised instabilities on steep terrain, snow cover good at higher altitudes.
