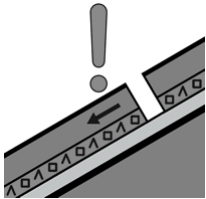


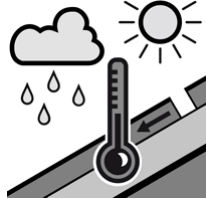

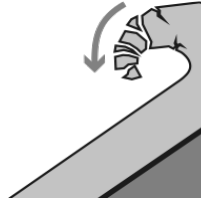

Persistent Weak Layers



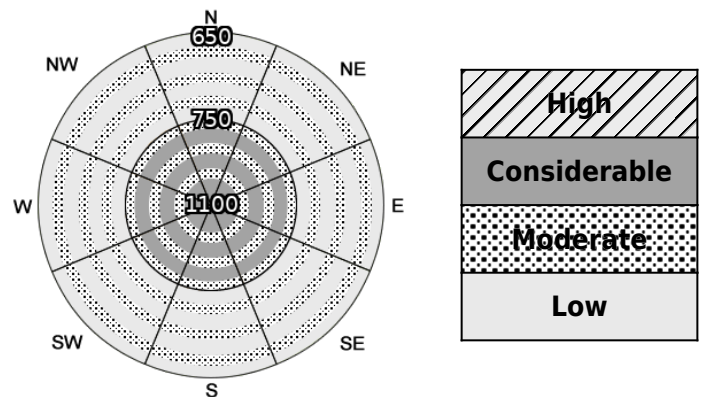
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A period of poor stability during the morning with rain at all levels. Wet slab and surface wet loose snow instability expected on steep slopes of all aspects above 750m. All cornices will be prone to collapse in the wet and milder conditions. Stability will improve in all locations with the onset of colder conditions in the afternoon. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Becoming mild overnight and into the early morning. Wet start to the day but turning colder later with a few snow showers. Strong South East winds veering Southerly, later South Westerly.

Comments

Ploughing through deep drifts away from the beaten path on Thursday. Freezing rain possible near summits overnight. Milder and wetter during the morning but colder in the afternoon.
